FROM THE OFFICE:**SUMMER MONTHS AND DOG RECREATION.****WHERE CAN I TAKE MY DOG?**

Off Leash Areas - Dogs can be exercised off-leash in:

- **Fenced Dog Parks** but must remain under the control of their carers at all times. [ACT Government link to locations of Fenced Dog Parks in the ACT.](#)
- **Designated off-leash dog exercise areas** can be viewed online or on maps at ACT libraries and Government shop-fronts. Please keep in mind that these open space areas are used for other recreational purposes too, so it is important that dogs remain under the control of their carers whilst exercising off leash. [ACT Government link to locations of Dogs Exercise Areas in the ACT.](#)

On Leash Areas –

You can take your dog to areas not otherwise designated as a Dog Exercise Area or a Dog Prohibited Area, but your dog must remain on the leash.

Dog Prohibited Areas –

Dogs Prohibited Areas are identified by signage and dogs are not permitted in these areas except for Assistance Dogs with permits.

- In public places not within 10 meters of a designated play space (if children are playing on it) or a fireplace (or heating appliance) designated for cooking, a child-care centre, preschool or primary school.
- A high school or secondary college during school hours or when school sports, including sport training or onto a field or playing area where sport is being played or training for sport is being conducted.

Dog Swimming Areas

- **Lakes** - Dogs are permitted to swim in most of Canberra's lakes provided they are not within 10 metres of a sign posted public swimming area. For information on the location of public swimming areas in Canberra contact Canberra Connect on 13 22 81.
- **Rivers** - On the Murrumbidgee River dogs are allowed to swim at Uriarra Crossing East; Uriarra Crossing West; Swamp Creek; and the western riverbank of Point Hut Crossing recreational area. Please note that on the eastern riverbank of Point Hut Crossing dogs must remain on-leash.

Dog Droppings –

All dog droppings in public places must be removed by the dog owner. It is an offence not to do so. It is also an offence to not carry appropriate equipment to pick up your dog's

droppings. An on-the-spot fine of \$50.00 can be issued by authorising officers if you do not pick up and dispose of your dog's droppings. An on-the-spot fine of \$50.00 can also be issued if you are not carrying appropriate equipment to collect your dog's droppings.

Gibraltar Forest Regeneration Area Closed to Dogs –

Gibraltar Forest Regeneration Area formerly known as Gibraltar Pines east of Corin Road, is now closed as a dog off-leash exercise area and dogs are prohibited.

This change is to safeguard domestic dogs from 1080 poison baits for wild dogs and foxes laid in this area. Baiting began in September 2010 and will continue indefinitely to protect livestock in the Tidbinbilla area. Warning signs are displayed at all entrances into the affected area.

Gibraltar Forest Regeneration Area to the west of Corin Road remains a dog off-leash exercise area. Dogs are also permitted on-lead at Woods Reserve.

➡ ACT GOVERNMENT POLICY - KEEPING 4 OR MORE DOGS

To have four or more dogs in the ACT you must have a keeper's licence issued by Domestic Animal Services (DAS). Dogs must be kept in accordance with the * *Domestic Animals Act 2000* and ** *Animal Welfare Act 2002*. This information is to help guide people that are considering keeping 4 or more dogs on one residential premise in the ACT. Under section 18 of the Domestic Animals Act 2000 it is an offence for a person to keep 4 or more dogs unless in accordance with a multiple dog licence.

Application Procedure –

Persons wishing to keep 4 or more dogs must make an application under section 19 of the *Domestic Animals Act 2000* for a multiple dog licence. An application form for "Keeping 4 or more dogs" can be obtained from DAS.

Prior to lodging your application each individual dog must be registered, micro-chip, de-sexed and hold or have lodged a permit to keep a sexual entire animal. You are also required to provide a map and photos of your premises, outlining any existing facilities and any proposed construction. A Ranger from Domestic Animal Service must also conduct a site inspection of your property and consult with surrounding residents.

The Registrar may take numerous things into consideration before granting a licence. The Act specifies that the following must be considered:

- The number and kind of dogs to which the application relates.
- The size and nature of the premises where the dogs are proposed to be kept.
- The security of the premises.
- The suitability of facilities for keeping the dogs on the premises.
- The potential impact on the neighbouring premises.

- Any conviction or finding of guilty of the applicant within the last 10 years against a Territory of State law for an offence relating to the welfare, keeping or control of an animal.

The Act also allows for other things to be considered that are not listed above, at the Registrar's discretion.

Minimum Requirements for Multiple Dog Licences.

- If you are a tenant in a property, written approval from you landlord.
 - There are no objections from your neighbours.
 - Pens or runs to be constructed in such a way that :
 - They are escape proof
 - No part of the structure is closer than 2 metres from a boundary fence
 - It is large enough to allow freedom of movement.
 - Has adequate shelter from the elements.
 - The floor of the structure facilitates hygienic disposal of the animal waste and ease of cleaning.
 - Adequate conditions for sanitary disposal of collected waste.
 - Dogs to be penned when the house is unattended (they may use the rest of the yard for exercise when you are home).

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES WHERE A CONTRACTED JUDGE HAS BEEN REPLACED.

A number of complaints and questions have been received over recent times by Affiliates and Exhibitors regarding the refund of entry fees from Affiliates by exhibitors who have for various reasons been unable to attend a show they have entered.

A similar article has appeared in the Dogs NSW Journal, so we hope that the following will clear any ambiguity in relations governing replacement judges.

The following extracts from the Dogs ACT Regulation
http://www.dogsact.org.au/RulesNRegs/Part_6_Show.pdf
clearly indicates how such circumstances are to be treated.

- ❖ Entry fees shall be paid at the time of lodging an application for entry. Such fee will be forfeited if the entry is accepted and the dog is not exhibited (Part 6 Show Regulations - Section 6.11).

Section 6.11 - Entry Fees:

- a) The entry fee payable in respect of each dog entered in a show shall be paid at the time of the lodging of an application for entry.
- b) An entry fee shall be forfeit if an application for entry of a dog as an exhibit is accepted and the dog is not exhibited or if the regulations are not observed.

Note: The only exception is - where a replacement Judge is used. In this case an exhibitor may request in writing prior to judging of the applicable class their intention to withdraw. (Part 6 Show Regulations - Section 6.16). There is no obligation for a Show secretary to refund an entry once it has been received, unless the one circumstance shown below occurs and the application is done in writing.

Section 6.16.h - Approval of a Show (Draft schedules):

Where the Show Schedule has published the name of the Judge who will adjudicate in a breed class:

- i. A dog may be withdrawn as an exhibit from such class if another person is appointed to judge there at, **and**
- ii. Only where a notice in writing of the intention to withdraw the exhibit is given by the exhibitor to the Show Committee prior to the judging of that class by the replacement judge.

The entry fee of any exhibit withdrawn in accordance with this Regulation must be refunded to the exhibitor by the Affiliate conducting the show.

➡ ANKC REGULATIONS PART6 - SECTION 3 - IMPORTED DOGS

3.1 An “imported dog” is one that has been imported into Australia from overseas including New Zealand. An imported dog is to be identified as such by (Imp UK), (Imp USA) etc. at the end of its name. A dog imported in dam is to be identified as such by (IID UK), (IID USA) etc. at the end of its name (10/06, 6.1.2) (Amended 10/10, 7.48)

3.2 All pedigree dogs that are imported into Australia (including those dogs whelped in Australia and previously exported from Australia) to be re-registered with ANKC Ltd must provide, at the time of registering the animal:

- Proof of identification, i.e. microchip or tattoo,
- Proof of importation, such as a "health permit", "export permit" or "import permit"
- Proof of their shipment from the country of origin to Australia such as a "Bill of Loading" and
- A Certified Export Pedigree in the Australian member's owners name showing all titles granted by the overseas body. (Amended 10/07, 7.6)

➡ **INCREASES IN THE ANKC BUDGET THAT WILL AFFECT CHARGES AND FEES FOR DOGS ACT SERVICES.**

The new or increase to existing ANKC levies started 1 January 2012. Dogs ACT has endeavoured to absorb as much of the increases as possible, but where our fees needed to be increased, the new fees started from 1 January 2012.

- ANKC Ltd Membership Levy for the year 2012 is set at \$3.91 per member;
- ANKC Ltd Registration levy increased \$1.10 per registration;
- Export Pedigree Surcharge remains unchanged at \$11.00 per dog exported;
- A \$1.10 fee (including GST) per transaction is now applicable for the following:

Associate Register Applications, Sporting Register Applications, Title Applications, Leases, Transfer of Ownership, Judge's Licences Applications, Judge's Licenses Renewals, Prefix Applications, Prefix Renewals, Prefix Transfers, Re-registration or imports and between registers, Reprints of Certificates (Registration & Pedigree).

➡ **DOGS ACT MEMBERSHIPS.**

To ensure that we continue to move in line with other state controls we must remind you –

- You cannot introduce a new person into an existing membership irregardless of whether they are family members or a new spouse. A new membership will be started & shared dogs transferred to that membership, cost may apply.
- Ensure that your breeding bitches are linked to the correct (prefix) membership.
- Your prefix must be linked to a continuous financial membership & where your prefix membership is unfinancial for a determined period you may have to re-apply for that prefix.
- When entering events that you include the correct membership number relevant to that exhibit.
- It is important that YOU know how many memberships you are involved with, whether should they be financial, are they financial?

➡ SUMMARY OF THE ANKC LTD BOARD MEETING HELD IN BRISBANE ON 15TH & 16TH OCTOBER, 2011

Amended/Updated regulations, publications and listings will be made available from the ANKC Ltd website.

At the October 2011 ANKC Ltd Board meeting, Directors resolved/considered the following:

- 1 Pre 1987 Kennel Club (England) Standards** - It was resolved that ANKC Ltd accepts the offer from the Kennel Club of the Pre 1987 Standards. ANKC Ltd will only alter the standards in respect of the tail descriptions where necessary but no other alterations will be entered into. Once the necessary alterations are made they will be called Australian breed standards and ANKC Ltd will retain the copyright.
- 2 ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 2, Clause 3.10** - It was resolved that Clause 3.10 be deleted in its entirety (including subclauses 3.10.1 and 3.10.2) from Regulations Part 2.
- 3 ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 3 – Amendments** - It was resolved to add/amend the following clauses in Regulations Part 3:
 - New Clause 1.4;
 - Amend Clause 6.1.
- 4 ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 5 – Amendments** - It was resolved to amend/add the following sections/clauses in Regulations Part 5:
 - Amend Section 1, Clause 1.1;
 - Amend Section 3;

- Amend Section 5, Clause 1 (a), (b), (c), (f);
 - Amend Clause 7.7;
 - Amend Clause 7.9;
 - New Clause 7.10.
- 5 Grand Champion Title** - It was resolved that from 1 January 2012 the requirements for the Grand Champion Title will revert back to the Pre 1 January 2010 requirement of 1,000 points only, and the requirements of: 1 All Breeds Best in Show; or 4 Best in Group; or 4 Certificates of 25 points will be removed.
All dogs that qualify for the Grand Champion title under Regulations Part 5 Clause 7.9 are eligible to apply for the title after the implementation date of 1 January 2012.
- 6 Supreme Champion Title – NEW** - It was resolved to introduce a new conformation title ‘Supreme Champion’. The requirements to attain this new title by using the points system as approved by ANKC Ltd at the time will be 1,000 points, including 3 All Breeds Best in Shows; or 10 Best in Group/Specialty Best in Shows. Either 3 different Best in Show Judges or 10 different Best in Group /Specialty judges must be submitted, there can be no repeated judges.
The implementation date of the new Supreme Champion title will be 1 July 2012.
- NOTE:** Both a Grand Champion and Supreme Championship will not be awarded to animals retrospectively, but an animal will be eligible to be awarded the title of Supreme Champion, if they gain some points towards the title of Supreme Champion (1000 points) after the implementation date of the 1 July 2012.
- 7 ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 6 – Amendments** -It was resolved to amend/add the following sections/clauses in Regulations Part 6:
- Amend Section 1, Clause 1.1;
 - New Clause 4.3.
- 8 ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 11 – Amendment** - It was resolved to amend the following clauses/chapters in Regulations Part 11:
- Amend Clause 4.1;
 - Amend Clause 4.4;
 - Amend Clause 4.5;
 - Amend Clause 4.6;
 - Amend Clause 4.9;
 - Amend Chapter 3;
 - Amend Chapter 5.
- 9 ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 13, Clauses 4.2.4 to 4.2.7 – Amendment** - It was resolved to amend Clauses 4.2.4 to 4.2.7 in Regulations Part 13. [Current Regulations 4.2.8 and 4.2.9 will be renumbered 4.2.7 and 4.2.8 respectively].
- 10 New Regulations Pertaining to Non Resident Dances with Dogs Judges** - It was resolved to adopt the new Regulations Pertaining to Non Resident Dances with Dogs Judges. These regulations will be available from the ANKC Ltd website.

- 11 ANKC Ltd Junior Handler Manual/Open Book Junior Handler Judges Exam** - It was resolved to adopt the amended Junior Handler Manual and the new Open Book Junior Handler Judges Exam.
- 12 ANKC Ltd ‘Judging Dogs in Australia Guidelines for Non Resident Judges’** - It was resolved to adopt the updated publication titled “Judging Dogs in Australia Guidelines for Non Resident Judges”.

CHANGES TO ANKC CONFORMATION TITLES

ANKC Regulation – Part 5 Show Section 7.7 – Australian Champion (amended 10/11).

The owner of a dog registered with the ANKC Ltd which:

- (a) Wins not fewer than four Challenge Certificates/Best of Breed Certificates under not fewer than four different Judges at four different exhibitions; and
- (b) Gains a total of 100 points; may apply for such dog to be known as a Champion.

REMOVED @10/11 - of which twenty five (25) of these points are gained after the age of twelve (12) months.

ANKC Regulation – Part 5 Show Section 7.8 – Neuter Champion

The owner of a neutered dog registered with the ANKC Ltd which:

- (a) Wins not fewer than four Neuter Certificates/Best Neuter of Breed Certificates under not fewer than four different Judges at four different exhibitions; and
- (b) Gains a total of 100 points, of which twenty five (25) of these points are gained after the age of twelve (12) months; may apply for such dog to be known as a Neutered Champion.

ANKC Regulation – Part 5 Show - Section 7.9 – Grand Champion (amended 10/11).

- a) Using the points system as approved by the ANKC Ltd at the time, an animal will be required to receive 1000 points to be eligible to the title of Grand Champion.
- b) All dogs that qualify for the Grand Champion title under Rule 7.9 are eligible to apply for the title after the implementation date of 1 January 2012.

- c) The implementation date for the awarding of the title of Grand Champion 1 January 1998.
- d) A Grand Championship **will not be awarded to animals retrospectively**, but an animal will be eligible to be awarded the title of Grand Champion, if they gain some points towards the title of Grand Champion (1000 points) after the implementation date of the 1 January 1998.

REMOVED @10/11 - the requirement for 1 best in show or 4 Best in Group/Specialty Best in Show or 25 point challenges.

ANKC Regulation – Part 5 Show - Section 7.10 – Supreme Champion – (New 10/11)

- a) Using the points system as approved by the ANKC Ltd at the time, an animal will be required to attain the following qualifications to be eligible to the title of Supreme Champion.
 - 1,000 points, including 3 All Breeds Best in Shows; or
 - 10 Best in Group/Specialty Best in Show.
 - Either 3 different Best in Show Judges or
 - 10 different Best in Group/Specialty judges must be submitted,
 - There can be no repeated judges.
- b) **The implementation date for the awarding of the title of Supreme Champion to be 1 July 2012.**
- c) A Supreme Championship **will not be awarded to animals retrospectively**, but an animal will be eligible to be awarded the title of Supreme Champion, **if they gain some points towards the title of Supreme Champion (1000 points) after the implementation date of the 1 July 2012.**



RETRIEVING & FIELD TRIAL “HALL OF FAME” 2012 ELECTIONS

In the first twelve years of elections, the Australian National Kennel Council Ltd has received nominations for 41 dogs and 20 people to be considered for induction into the Retrieving & Field Trial Hall of Fame. From the nominations received, twenty one outstanding dogs and fourteen exceptional people have been inducted into the Hall of Fame.

The criteria for the two categories for selection are the following:

1. Outstanding Gundogs: (may be deceased or retired from further competition)

- (a) Their record as a winning dog i.e., CLUB – STAKE – DATE – JUDGE PLACE and/or
- (b) Their production record.
- (c) Subject to the receipt of a formal application, dogs that have been awarded the title of Grand Champion and have gained a total number of points equal to, or greater than, twice the total number required for that award, shall automatically be inducted into the Hall of Fame. Such applications must include full particulars and a brief resume of the dog's career.
- (d) Subject to the receipt of a formal application, dogs winning at least two National Championships in the same discipline shall automatically be inducted into the Hall

of Fame. Such applications must include full particulars and a brief resume of the dog's career.

- (e) The eligibility for a dog should be based on its entire competitive career and previous record as a producer, not merely for a particular win or for a heroic deed within the field and retrieving trial sphere.

2. **Prominent Persons:**

Their record of a broad combination of accomplishments as:

- (a) Club official
- (b) Judge
- (c) Owner
- (d) Handler

The distinction of nomination should be accorded to those who have made outstanding contributions to the field or retrieving game. Nominees should be **givers** to the sport and not **takers**.

Nominations are now being called for the thirteenth year of elections. In addition to applications submitted in relation to Outstanding Gundogs 1(c) and 1(d), a maximum of two prominent persons and two outstanding gundogs may be elected each year.

Nomination:

1. Clubs or Members shall nominate DOGS and PEOPLE considered worthy of awards, including full details of accomplishments within the above categories and with verification. In the case of dogs, nominations should include the full name, title, owner and date of birth.

[Please note it is a condition of nomination that the nominator/s provides accurate written material supporting the nomination. In the absence of such accurate supporting material, or should the supporting material later prove to be inaccurate in areas of significance, the Selection Panel for the ANKC Ltd Retrieving & Field Trial Hall of Fame reserves the right to reconsider its decision and if appropriate, delete the name of the Prominent Person or Distinguished Dog from the list of inductees.]

2. **Nominations shall close on the 30 June, 2012** at respective Member Body offices for forwarding to ANKC Ltd.



GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG – (LONG STOCK COAT LANGSTOCKHAAR)

At the October 2011 ANKC Ltd Board meeting the following submission received from the German Shepherd Dog Council (Australia) was endorsed.

1. Registrations of German Shepherd Dogs (Long Stock Coat – Langstockhaar) are to commence immediately
2. Showing of German Shepherd Dogs (Long Stock Coat – Langstockhaar) will commence 1st January 2012.

3. ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 6 has been amended to include the following new Clause 9.13 with existing Clauses 9.13 to 9.21 being renumbered to 9.14 to 9.23.

New Clause 9.13:

- 9.13 German Shepherd Dog (Stock Coat – Stockhaar) and German Shepherd Dog (Long Stock Coat – Langstockhaar).
- 9.13.1 Both **coat varieties are to be** judged separately with each variety receiving separate Challenge Certificates.
- 9.13.2 Inter-variety breeding is NOT permitted and will not be approved for Registration purposes on either register
- 9.13.3 Reclassification (*1see below) on coat type for animals born before 1st January 2012 is permitted up until 1st January 2014.
- 9.13.4 German Shepherd Dogs (Long Stock Coat - Langstockhaar) that have been registered on the ANKC “Limited Register” can be upgraded to the ANKC “Main Register” by using the normal procedure provided they have been reclassified or classified as Long Stock Coat.
- 9.13.5 Progeny that are Stock Coat (Stockhaar) bred from two [2] Stock Coat (Stockhaar) dogs will be registered on the ANKC Main or Limited Register and marked with a Stock Coat (Stockhaar) identifier/number.
- 9.13.6 Progeny that are classified (*2see below) as a Long Stock Coat (Langstockhaar), being bred from two [2] Stock Coat (Stockhaar) dogs will be registered on the ANKC Main or Limited Register and marked with a Long Stock Coat identifier/number
- 9.13.7 Progeny bred from two [2] registered Long Stock Coat (Langstockhaar) dogs will be registered on the ANKC Main or Limited Register and marked with a **Long Stock Coat (Langstockhaar) identifier/number.**
- 9.13.8 All **existing GSD Litter Registration Limitations (LRLs)** apply to both **coat varieties.**

***1Reclassification for animals born before 1st January, 2012.**

Proof of ANKC Ltd registration in owners name is required. Identification by Microchip or Tattoo must be checked and confirmed.

Long Stock Coat (Langstockhaar) dogs are to be submitted for an examination and verification by three [3] current GSDCA Specialist GSD judges in capital city metropolitan locations. (GSDCA affiliate clubs to offer this service regularly at Breed Surveys and/or Shows).

In remote locations the preferred option is by one current GSDCA Specialist GSD judge, and two current licensed ANKC Group 5 Judges. If this is not practicable then animals can be verified by three (3) Current ANKC Group 5 judges.

Confirmation that a dog is a Long Stock Coat (Langstockhaar) is submitted to the relevant Canine Kennel Control in the State or Territory where dog is registered. (See attached proposed form).

Verified dogs may be registered on the Main or Limited Register as a Long Stock Coat (Langstockhaar) variety, including provision of cross-transfers between each the ANKC Main or Limited Long Coat Register.

Procedure for animals born after 1st January, 2012:

- Registered according to their coat type by breeder.
- Once registered, any changes from Long Stock Coat register to Stock Coat register, or Stock Coat register to Long Stock Coat register, can only be done on verification of coat type by 3 current GSDCA Specialist Judges in capital city metropolitan locations.
- In remote locations the preferred option is by 1 GSDCA Specialist Judge and 2 current licenced ANKC group 5 Judges. If this is not practical, animals can be verified by 3 current licenced ANKC Group 5 Championship Show Judges.

The German Shepherd Dog Breed Standard will now encompass the Long coat variety and is in line with the country of origin standard (Germany) and other than the highlighted minor details, the GSDCA Standard previously adopted by the ANKC.

HEALTH and WELFARE

DOGS ACT TAIL DOCKING POLICY

There have been amendments to the *ACT - Animal Welfare (Welfare of Dogs in the ACT) Code of Practice 2010* that place a different responsibility on Dogs ACT members in relation to docking of dog tails in the ACT.

Dogs A.C.T Regulations - Part 4 - The Register & Registration.
Section 4.15 Registration of Docked Dogs:

- a) Any docked dog registered in the ACT, the purpose for the docking of the tail whether by surgical or other means must be in accordance with the regulations of Dogs A.C.T and any rule, condition or legislation of the ACT Government.
- b) Any docked dog registered with another State Canine Control, it will be taken that the purpose for the docking of the tail whether by surgical or other means had been done in accordance with the regulations of that State Canine Control and the laws of that state in which the surgical procedure was carried out. (Amend 22.9.2009)
- c) Any docked dog that does not conform to Sections 4.15.a or 4.15.b of these regulations will be deemed to be a Non Registrable Docked Dog.
- d) At no time may a Non Registrable Docked Dog be registered or remain on the register; or be exhibited or shown at an exhibition or show.
- e) During any suspension of registration of a Non Registrable Docked Dog, the dog may not be exhibited in any exhibition or show; be bred with or used at stud; and/or subject of a transfer.

ACT - Animal Welfare (Welfare of Dogs in the ACT) Code of Practice 2010
Section 10.2 - Tail docking and ear cropping

The ACT *Animal Welfare Act 1992* prohibits the docking of a dog's tail or cropping of ears. An exception exists that will allow a veterinarian to perform a tail-docking procedure at any stage of a dog's life for a therapeutic reason.

Australian Capital Territory Animal Welfare Act 1992
Part 2 – Section 8 – Pain

- A person commits an offence if the person causes an animal unnecessary pain.
- A person in charge of an animal commits an offence if-
Fails to provide appropriate and adequate, food, water, shelter or exercise; or Fails to take reasonable steps (including, if appropriate, seeking veterinary treatment) to alleviate any pain suffered by the animal; or Abandons the animal; Neglects the animal in a way that causes it pain; or Kills the animal in a way that causes it unnecessary pain.

Australian Capital Territory Animal Welfare Act 1992
Part 2 Section - 19A Medical and surgical procedures - Veterinary surgeons

- A veterinary surgeon must not do any of the following for a purpose other than a therapeutic purpose - Dock a dog's tail; crop a dog's ear; carry out any other procedure prescribed by regulation.
- A veterinary surgeon must not carry out a medical or surgical procedure on an animal for a cosmetic purpose only.

➔ ACT GOVERNMENT POLICY – DANGEROUS/ NUISANCE DOGS

Dangerous Dogs – There are no restricted breeds in the ACT as each dog is assessed on its individual behaviour and history. A dangerous dog is:

- A dog that the Registrar of Domestic Animal Services has declared to be dangerous usually because of attack behaviour, or
- Having been declared dangerous in another State or Territory, or
- A dog which has been trained as a guard dog, or is kept as a guard dog for guarding premises other than residential premises.

If a dog has been declared dangerous, the owner must apply for a Dangerous Dog Licence from DAS. License will only be granted if the Registrar is satisfied that the dog can be kept in accordance with strict conditions designed to ensure public safety.

Animal Nuisances – The Domestic Animals Act 2002 states that an animal nuisance exists if the keeping or behaviour of an animal causes a condition, state or activity that constitutes-

- a. Damage to property owned by a person other than the keeper; or
- b. Excessive disturbance to a person other than the keeper because of noise; or
- c. Danger to the health of an animal or a person other than the keeper.

Generally nuisance behaviour relates to excessive noise caused by a dog barking. It should be noted that all dogs bark to some degree and only some barking behaviour meets the criteria for “nuisance” as described above.

ACT Government advice to victims of a perceived nuisance animal: It is recommended that prior to lodging a complaint that you speak to your neighbours about the problem that you are having. Some people are unaware that their animals are causing a problem. Sometimes this direct approach will rectify the problem quickly.

In lodging an animal nuisance complaint you must demonstrate that the nuisance exists and has been ongoing for an extended period of time in excess of three weeks and how the nuisance behaviour is impacting upon you. To demonstrate the frequency and regularity of the nuisance they ask that you complete a bark diary for a period of 14 days. This information is essential when DAS is holding discussions with the dog owner to demonstrate the nature of nuisance behaviour and when it is occurring so that they can take steps to address the issue.

The Domestic Animals Act 2000 states that the Registrar must investigate any written animal nuisance complaint unless satisfied that the complaint is frivolous or vexatious.

➡ ACT DOG WINS THE 42ND NATIONAL RETRIEVING TRIAL

Relevant Affiliates from all Member Bodies of the ANKC conduct Retrieving Trials for Gundogs. Events may be conducted at Novice, Restricted (intermediate), All Age (Open) and State or National Championship level. On a rotating basis hosting the National Championship is shared between each of the States, except for Dogs NT.

The 42nd National Retrieving Trial Championship was hosted by Dogs NSW and was conducted in the Jugiong area on the 9th, 10th and 11th of September 2011.

The event was judged by Messrs Joe Law (Runs 1, 4, 5 & 8); Jack Lynch (Runs 2, 3, 6 & 7); both judges reside in NSW. Each Run (or Test) required the dogs to recover three items of game. A total of 43 dogs were entered with competitors coming from WA, VIC, NSW, QLD and the ACT. The field included 16 Labrador Males, 17 Labrador Females, 1 Golden Retriever Male, 2 Golden Retriever Females, 1 German Shorthair Pointers Male, 2 German Shorthair Pointers Females, 1 Chesapeake Bay Retriever Male, 1 Weimaraner Male, 1 Curly Coat Retriever Male and 1 Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Male.

The AWRC Retrieving Trial Dog of the Year competition is open to all dogs competing in ANKC Retrieving Trials conducted anywhere in Australia with points being awarded on a sliding scale ranging from 12 points for 1st Place in a Championship down to 1 point for 3rd Place in a Novice Stake.

**20th Anniversary
1991-2011**



On Saturday 17 September 2011, fifty two agility enthusiasts gathered at the ACT Companion Dog Club's grounds at Symonston on a splendid spring day to commemorate the 20th anniversary of sanctioned agility trials in the ACT.

The celebrations were jointly hosted by Dogs ACT and the ACT Companion Dog Club and featured a regular agility and jumping trial in the morning followed by a barbeque and a novelty event open to all-comers in the afternoon. The commemorative trial attracted 223 entries, compared to only 22 entries for the first trial in September 1991.

The novelty event was conducted according to the official 1991 ANKC agility rules and featured the course layout used at the first trial. The original judge, Mr Sid Schuck, kindly agreed to officiate at the commemorative event. While the design of the course was very basic compared to today's tricky courses – with only nine obstacles laid out in a simple figure eight - the challenge faced by competitors was to only handle their dog on the left (as per the style of handling back in 1991). This saw many competitors and their dogs disqualified – unable to avoid the temptation to switch sides while negotiating the course.

Not surprisingly, the top three place-getters for the novelty event were all experienced agility and obedience triallers, with their dogs happy to heel between obstacles to maintain control and position. Congratulations to the following for their success on the day:

Results for the regular agility and jumping classes appeared in the last edition of the *Dogs ACT Journal* (Volume 46 No 4).



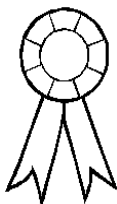

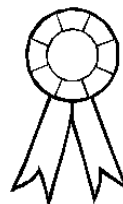
