Dogs ACT Obedience Stewards Course 2011

Applications are invited from Dogs ACT Members over 15 years and resident in the ACT who wish to undertake the Obedience Stewards Course. Successful completion of the course will qualify candidates to be placed on the Dogs ACT Obedience Stewards Panel and those between the ages of 15 and 18 will be placed on the Junior Stewards Panel until they are 18.

Everyone interested in trialling or in stewarding at Obedience trials are urged to attend – Clubs are always searching for qualified stewards for their trials and this is one way of contributing to the sport of dog obedience. Also, an official stewarding qualification is a pre-requisite for those intending to undertake judges training in due course.

Interstate Members are reminded that they are eligible to undertake the course provided their Canine Control has no objections. They should seek their Controlling Body's approval and provide written evidence of such approval with their application. Successful interstate Members will be placed on the Supplementary Stewards Panel.

The course will consist of an hour (approximate) lecture followed by two hours 'hands on' practical training. Candidates will need to have available a copy of the Rules for the Conduct of Obedience Trials. Rule Books are available from Dogs ACT (\$5.00) or possibly from your Club.
